## What a typical Small Group Ministry might look like:

Small Group Ministry is made up of 6-10 members who have committed to meeting together twice monthly for a period of 6-10 months. In June the group celebrates the journey and disbands.

Groups are guided by a trained facilitator to explore diverse and significant topics. In 2014-2015 topics will be inspired by UUC's monthly worship themes.

Groups will meet either at UUC or in members homes.

#### **Small Group Ministries**

#### How do you want to live your life?

Ever stopped to consider it? In a busy world, it can be hard to take the time to sit down and think with intent about how we want to live our lives. Intention requires creating a vision for ourselves, planning goals, and implementing those activities that move us toward the vision.

But, of course, life has a habit of happening in spite of our plans. So it is our *attitude* toward what happens that makes a difference in how our life rolls along through the years.

Small Group Ministry groups of 6-10 people can help us create that attitude, make those plans and feel better about ourselves, the people around us and our congregation.

Each group crafts its own covenant, or set of ground rules on how members interact. The covenant works to create a safe space for deep sharing and personal reflection and generally includes guidelines for confidentiality.

New members are received into Small Group Ministry twice during the year, and agreements are made regarding how to welcome new members when they join. Small Group Ministry is open to all UUC members and friends.



The aim is to celebrate and talk about our individuality, discover personal truths, find meaning in our lives, live our principles and make contributions to our congregation and our community.

#### WHAT WILL WE BE DOING?

#### Searching:

A desire for change and curiosity Propel movement to search for questions and answers.

#### Discovering:

Discovery can occur as an "AHA" moment, or it may take a long time to sink in.

#### Assimilating:

Mold the new into existing scheme of attitudes, values, beliefs and faith.

#### Sharing:

Once you have drawn the picture of your truth, this novel new word portrait of yourself demands to be shared...
